They are currently cleaning out our courtyard, painting and planting to make an outdoor inclusive space where all children are welcome

- 3. Truth and Reconciliation Calls to Action —On Oct. 1, our school staff worked with our students in raising awareness for truth and reconciliation: calls to action. This was a wonderful morning for our students to gather with other grades in fostering relationships and strengthening friendships while walking together collectively towards reconciliation. There were many activities and each part having such great significance towards reflecting on the legacy of residential schools and in honoring the survivors and children who never got to go home. Our participation and intention for this morning allowed our school family to learn, recognize, and broaden our knowledge and understanding of indigenous lived experiences.
- 4. <u>Clubs</u>: Arcade Club, Student Council elections, Board Game Club, GO Green Club, Rec Leadership Club, Worship Team and Choir Club
- 5. **Sport Teams** our JH Cross country came 3<sup>rd</sup> in the entire city and our Sr Girls won first place. We also had our Elementary Cross Country Run, Sr Boys Soccer won the silver medal and our Sr. Girls Soccer won the gold, Jr Boys and Girls VB occurring, and Sr. Boys and Girls occurring
- 6. Safety we have engaged in 4 Fire Drills and 1 Lockdown in practicing safety protocols
- 7. <u>City Safety</u> Principal has worked with the City of Edmonton Transportation for 4 years to change the front of the school to One Way, put in a All Way Stop at South end of the school, put in an All Way Stop at North end of the school, and put in a double crosswalk.
- 8. Patrols we have our Gr. 6 students out at the crosswalks for patrolling student crossing
